EMS Volunteers in this area have grown to become a responsible and valuable tool in the provision of pre hospital care. The earlier the care is available, the better the outcome!

As an EMS Youth Corps Member you will receive training in:

- CPR, First Aid, and Responding to Emergencies (RTE)
- Communication, leadership, and decision making skills
- Career Opportunities in the Emergency Service field.
